

Finding the Boat Park





The boat park is on Llandudno Promenade directly opposite the Sailing Club. From the A55 (Junction 19 – Glan Conwy Corner), follow the signs for Llandudno eventually entering the town along the dual carriageway (Conwy Rd). Turn right at the Links Hotel onto the B5115. At the second roundabout turn left and then immediately right onto the Promenade where you will be met by Club Stewards.

Parking your boat and registration

On arrival on the Promenade you will be allocated a dinghy berth where you may park your boat. Leaving your car and boat, please cross the road and register in the Race Office (signposted). On completion of registration, please return to your car and remove it at the earliest opportunity from the Promenade. Cars will only be allowed to return when your boat is ready to drive away at the end of the event.

Car Parking

There is limited parking at the clubhouse. Please avoid using this if at all possible.

Like many sea-side areas, parking can be a problem. There is metered parking on the Promenade.

The club

You will find the club opposite the entrance to the Promenade dinghy park. Please take care when crossing the road as traffic begins to accelerate as it leaves the adjacent roundabout.

You will be able to get drinks and food at the club especially before going out to sail or on return. During the day the club will be open for family members and friends for hot drinks, snacks and bar facilities. The club will be used for briefings and the event's main social activities.

There are limited changing facilities, showers and toilets in the clubhouse.

Administration

The Race Office is located on the ground floor at the front of the Clubhouse. The 'Official Noticeboard' will be located nearby.

Cyclists

Cyclists may use the Promenade with care.

Motorhomes

Overnight parking of motorhomes on the Club premises and the Promenade is strictly forbidden.
